Good evening Iron Hill Scouters:

Last week I sent out a notice about signatures on the final Eagle application, and that it should be the one verified by Carol Swank. After discussing this with Carol here is a clarification. Yes, the one that goes to national needs all signatures, and Carol's electronic signature. Carol provides me a verified copy for the BOR and sometimes that is the one signed off by the Eagle candidate plus other required signatures and sometimes it is not. What she would like to see is a high quality copy of the application, in color, that she can then attach her signature to. If it is not good enough she will submit a companion copy with the one that the BOR signs. So – you do not need to sign the copy that Carol has verified, but it would be very helpful for the copy that is submitted to be a high resolution scan, not a cell phone photo of the application! Carol and I will work out the final copy that will go to national. If you have any questions on this please let me know.

Submitting the Eagle Project Workbook:

Please see the attached Eagle project submittal process that is taken from the Life to Eagle presentation and the process to accept a MEGA invite. Please have your Eagle candidates follow this procedure. **Emailing me a brief one sentence email with attached files or links to a google or other cloud drive will no longer be accepted.** I have received these links in the past only to find I was not a user of a particular cloud service and therefore the documents were not available to me. As I have noted in Life to Eagle presentations and prior emails, often I can receive these documents, but then I cannot forward them to others for review as their email servers do not allow such large files. All files are uploaded for the reviewers as well as for the Scout to add edited documents if they become necessary. This is a very easy process and we have had really good luck over the last year using it.

Service Project Fundraisers:

A recent project fundraiser submitted for an Eagle project planned to use a raffle as the fundraiser. Scouting rules prohibit games of chance for fundraising for Eagle Projects, as well as other unit and Scout fundraisers, and raffles fall into that area. So please make sure that any of your Eagle candidates do not use this approach for their projects. I have attached a letter outlining tips for fundraisers you may find helpful for Eagle and general fundraising. Note also that Joe Corbi's Pizza is also not allowed. Some time ago they used BSA logos inappropriately and were banned from further sources of fundraising.
